RATIONALE

The operations of the CSA are partially funded by fees levied on its membership as per the Post-Secondary Learning Act (Alberta). A policy is needed to define what these fees are and how they are assessed and collected.

EXPECTATIONS

Item I – General

1. CSA Membership fees are collected by the Office of the University Registrar.
2. CSA Fees are reviewed annually by the President and Vice President of Finance in consultation with the General Manager subject to approval by the General Council.

Item II – Membership Fees

1. All General Members of the CSA are assessed a membership fee each term.
 - 1.1. Students are assessed fees per credit, to a maximum of nine credits per term.
 - 1.2. The CSA membership fee is \$13 per credit.

Item III – Dedicated Fees

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1. Additional fees assessed to students are established by simple majority of members at referendum.
